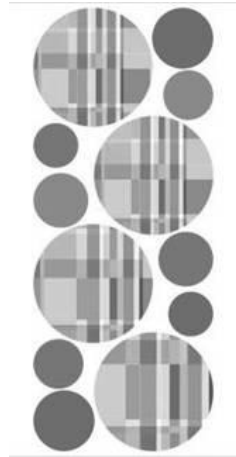


Mountain Laurel Quilt Guild 2012 Alzheimer's Art Quilt Initiative Competition

Rules

The Alzheimer's Art Quilt Initiative Competition quilts need not be about Alzheimer's or any particular subject at all, but the quilts must contain at least one polka dot fabric and one plaid fabric. Any theme, style, color, technique, and ability are welcome.

Finished quilts must be no larger than 9" x 12". No exceptions.

Please use “Fast Finish Triangles” to prepare your quilt for hanging. Full instructions can be found online at www.alzquilts.org/paqdisplay.html

If the design used is from a pattern or any other source not your own, **permission** of the copyright holder in writing must be secured before your quilt can be registered with AAQI.

Quilts must be free from any embellishments that cannot withstand the "careful" care provided by the USPS.

Your quilt must have a label securely stitched to the lower right hand corner of the back of the quilt. The label should contain the name of the quilt, your first and last name, city and state.

Finished quilts accompanied with a completed Priority: Alzheimer's Quilt Project registration form must be handed in to Susan McConnell before or on Monday, August 20, 2012. Registration forms can be found and printed at <http://lib.store.yahoo.net/lib/yhst-40258611477147/Goddess.pdf>

AAQI Competition quilts will be on display during the Mountain Laurel Quilt Guild's 2012 Exhibit. All AAQI Competition quilts will be donated to AAQI at the end of the exhibit.

By entering a quilt in the MLQG Competition you are agreeing to donate your quilt to AAQI. Quilts will be sold by auction (Internet, live, or silent) or sold outright at the discretion of the Executive Director. All profits will be used to fund Alzheimer's research. Each donation quilt will have its own web page and the purchase price of the quilt will be listed on the AAQI website (www.alzquilts.org).
